8. Petition from Eugene and Arlene Badtke (owners) to rezone 10 acres of Tax Parcel #45-4-221-132-0111 from A-1, Farmland Preservation District to A-2, General Agricultural. The proposed parcel would be approximately 400' x 1,090'. The parcel would be located approximately 805' east of the intersection of Hwy MB and Hwy E on the south side of Highway E. The purpose of the division would be to allow the construction of a single family home.
9. Petition from Eugene and Arlene Badtke (owners) to rezone 10 acres of Tax Parcel #45-4-221-132-0111 from A-1, Farmland Preservation District to A-2, General Agricultural. The proposed parcel would be approximately 400' x 1,090'. The parcel would be located approximately 1,205' east of the intersection of Hwy MB and Hwy E on the south side of Highway E. The purpose of the division would be to allow the construction of a single family home.
