Petition from Garry and Meagan Dillon (owners) for three variances from the Kenosha County Zoning ordinance for Tax Parcel 45-4-221-364-0420 located at 12100 60th Street with regard to repair/rebuilding of existing outbuildings in an A-2 District. The parcel is a pre-existing non conforming parcel in the district. The parcel is subject to the standards of an R-2 parcel. The petitioners are requesting a variance from the provision that a secondary outbuilding be of no more than 150 square feet (requesting 451.6 square feet); a variance from the provision restricting the height of a secondary outbuilding to 15 feet (21.5 feet requested); and a variance from the provision that requires a side yard setback of no less than 5 feet for a building (requesting 0.7 foot setback) to allow for the retention of an existing car port attached to the primary outbuilding. The purpose of the petition is to allow for the remodeling and preservation of the existing outbuildings.
