

DECEMBER 11, 2006 – SPECIAL MEETING

On Monday, December 11, 2006, the Town Board of the Town of Paris held a Special Meeting at the Paris Safety Building for the purpose of Discussion and Possible action regarding building renovations.

Chairman Gentz called the meeting to order at 4:40 pm, with the following persons present: Chairman Virgil Gentz; Supervisors, Ken Monson and Jeff Ashmus; Clerk/Treasurer, Linda Terry; and Mr. Todd Peyron from Camosy Construction.

There was discussion regarding the windows in the Clerk's room going from floor to ceiling. The consensus of the Board is to not have the glass going all the way to the floor – this will eliminate the use of the West wall.

Mr. Peyron will get the Board examples of buildings that have the windows to the floor so that they can see how they look.

Supervisor Monson would like to make sure that there is an emergency exit door in the meeting room.

Mr. Peyron stated that there is one planned for that area.

It was stated that there will be either mulch or stone around the bushes outside of the building.

The berm will be removed and waterproofing will be done.

Mr. Peyron will be contacting Van's roofing to have two men come to the town hall for a half of day to do any patching on anything showing the possibility of leaking. He stated it would cost approximately \$800.00.

The next meeting with Camosy will take place **January 8th at 4:30 pm.**

The meeting was adjourned at 5:30 pm, on an ASHMUS/MONSON MOTION. MOTION CARRIED 3-0.
