It was stated that the electrical service would be increased to 600 AMP service.

Supervisor Monson question the increase.

Chairman Gentz would be in favor of the increase.

Camosy will make sure the electrical will work for the flagpole.

Camosy will be in charge of surveying all of the property.

More receptacles will be added to the meeting room.

Outside lights can be programmed to go on and off.

Two lights will be added to the back parking lot.

Ryan Rudie, the architect asked about grades for the property.

Chairman Gentz stated that Kenosha Grounds has the corrected grades for the property.

Todd and Ryan will have a surveyor coming out to the property.

There were concerns regarding snowplowing around the monument.

It was suggested possible putting curb and gutter around the monument.

Chairman Gentz; Todd Peyron and Attorney Knuteson will meet informally regarding bids.

The Town will receive the bid documents within a week.
