

**NOVEMBER 22, 2005  
TOWN OF PARIS  
2006 PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING**

The Town of Paris Public Budget hearing was called to order at 6:34 p.m. on November 22, 2005, by Chairman Virgil Gentz, with all members in attendance. Residents in attendance were Ron Kammerzelt, Clyde and Jane Fillmore and Mike Christensen. The pledge preceded the meeting.

Terri read through the numbers and totals of the proposed budget for the year 2006. Monson noted that at the last town board meeting, a resolution was passed to take money out of the vehicle replacement account to cover road expenses and now truck 5511 will possibly be out of service. He would like to adjust the funds in that account in order to possibly replace a truck in 2006 and not have to wait until 2007. The account currently has \$23,155.00 left in it. Gentz noted the big jump in fire/rescue salaries which will put two full time employees available during the day for calls. He also noted the many repairs to the municipal building of which are hiring an architect, repairs to the roof, windows, berms, painting, caulking, blacktopping, etc. and purchasing a generator.

With there being no other questions, on a Monson/Ashmus motion and second, the public hearing was adjourned at 6:55pm. Motion passed with all yes votes.

**SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF THE ELECTORS**

The special town meeting of the electors of the Town of Paris was called to order at 6:55pm. Gentz informed the board that the work is done on Silvernail Road aka 128<sup>th</sup> Avenue. We usually try to do one road per year. Monson made a motion to approve the 2006 highway expenditures of \$175,000.00. Gentz made the second. Motion passed with all yes votes. On a Monson/Ashmus motion and second, the special town meeting of the electors was adjourned at 6:57pm.

**SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING**

The special town board meeting was called to order at 6:57pm. Town Atty. John Knuteson informed the board that if they thought the town would possibly take delivery of a new truck in 2006, we can amend the budget prior to its approval. Discussion took place to amend the budget by moving \$150,000.00 of surplus funds to the vehicle replacement account. All members were in agreement. Monson made a motion to adopt the 2006 town budget as amended. Ashmus made the second. Motion passed with all yes votes. On an Ashmus/Monson motion and second, the special town board meeting was adjourned at 7:11pm.
